

The Lord's Supper

According to Jesus in Mt. 16:24, following Jesus involves denying ourselves (selflessness) and taking up our cross (sacrifice). Jesus was certainly selfless when he left heaven to live on the earth for about thirty years and then died on the cross to pay the penalty for our sins. His sacrifice is hard to imagine.

When we take Communion, often called the Lord's Supper, we are remembering what Jesus did on the cross. His body was broken and His blood was shed, symbolized by partaking of the bread and the cup. Basically we are indicating that Jesus died for us and we have trusted Him as our Savior and want to live for Him.

Paul talks about the Lord's Supper in 1 Cor. 11:23-28. In verse 26 he adds a concept we sometimes forget. "For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes." The key is to share the gospel, the good news that we are saved by faith in Jesus and what He did on the cross. We will take the Lord's Supper again Friday. This week is a great opportunity to tell our world about Jesus and invite them to worship with us Easter Sunday.
