GOOD NEWS

When Paul was declaring the gospel, the good news about Jesus, to the church at Corinth in 1 Cor. 15:3-8, this is what he said. "For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, and that He was seen...." The gospel boils down to the fact that Jesus died for our sins and He rose again. That He was buried is proof of His death; that He was seen is proof of His resurrection.

Our responsibility is twofold. Number one, to believe the gospel. To depend on Jesus to save us because He died on the cross to pay the penalty for our sins.
