Christianity

Christianity is more than checking the boxes. It is first and foremost a relationship with Jesus Christ that results in everlasting and abundant life (Jn. 3:16; 10:10). But God's word delineates clearly steps that we need to take. The first is to trust Jesus as Savior and Lord. God created us to have fellowship with Him, but sin broke our fellowship with God. But, according to Rom. 5:8, "God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were sinners, Christ died for us." Our responsibility is to believe in Jesus, to receive Him as Savior and Lord (Jn. 1:12). Have you depended on Jesus to save you from your sins and give you everlasting life?

After trusting Christ as Savior, we need to be baptized, not in order to be saved but because we have been saved. Baptism is an act of obedience that we take after believing. In Acts 2:41, after Peter preached on the Day of Pentecost, "those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them." After they were saved, they were baptized and became part of the church. When you are baptized, you are saying Christ died for your sins, was buried, and rose again and that you have trusted Him as Savior and Lord. And you are indicating that you want to walk in newness of life (Rom. 6:4). Have you been baptized by immersion and joined the church?

The disciples in Acts 2 learned God's word together, in the temple and in small groups, they served, and they gave. Are you doing the same?
