In 1 Tim. 4:8-9, Paul exhorts a young pastor named Timothy to exercise himself toward godliness because even though bodily exercise profits a little, godliness is extremely profitable in this life and the life to come (heaven). Two other words used for exercise in other translations are discipline and training. As Christians, we should discipline ourselves or train ourselves toward godliness. If we put as much effort into being godly as we do in making money or being popular or being happy or whatever, we would be different people, this would be a different world, and God would be glorified. We would be pressing toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus (Phil. 3:14). Pleasing God is far more important than winning a Super Bowl.
